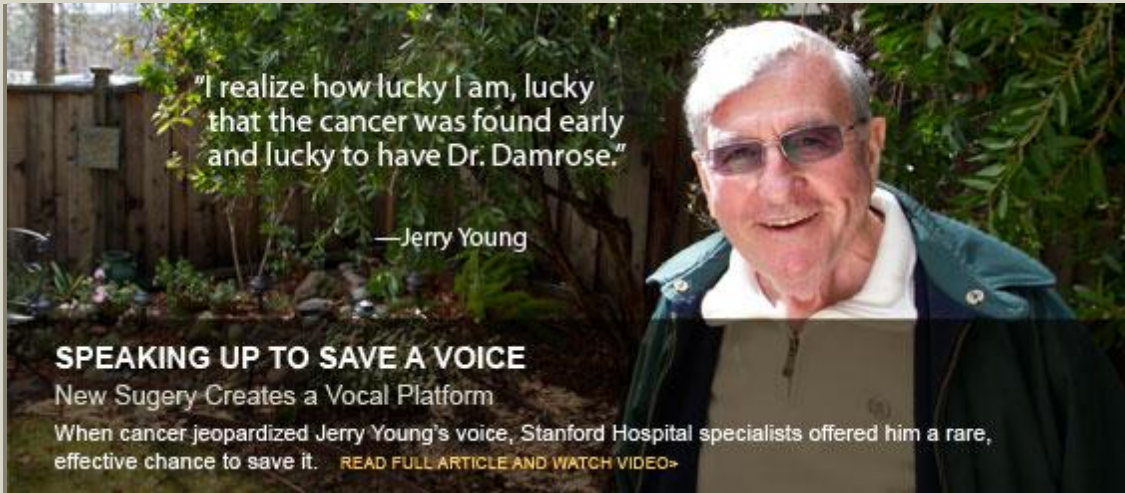

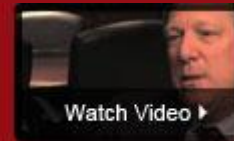


SHC Earns Top Rank in U.S. News & World Report's Best Hospitals Metro Area Rankings
