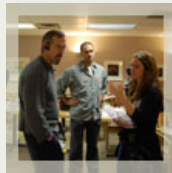

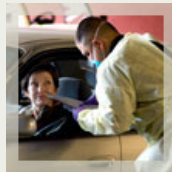
### SHC Medical Relief Team Treats Earthquake Survivors in Haiti

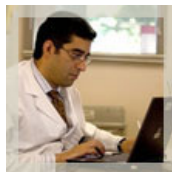
### Palliative Care Program Helps Patients in Making End-of-life Decisions

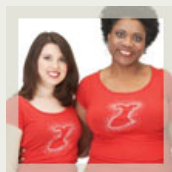
### Stanford Study Shows Drive-Through Emergency Service Effective

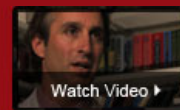
